Please join us for a parent-infant class in our Nido, the Montessori prepared environment for infants. This class led by our Birth through 3 years old trained teacher, Laura and is designed to offer support to the work of parenting and a chance to observe an environment that encourages exploration for the infant. There will be weekly discussion topics on weaning, toileting, the child's home environment, movement and language development, and anything else that is of interest to the group.

Parents will also have the opportunity to spend time each week on developing the skill and art of observation of their child. Observation allows us to come to a deeper understanding of the individual the child is becoming every day. Dr. Montessori's work evolved from her observations of young children. She observed the essence of human beings, which makes this educational method timeless. We will learn to be more present in mind, body and spirit and to observe children objectively.
